Stakeholders and advocacy meetings taking place in Tunis and Amman

The project “SouthMed WiA – Towards Greater Gender Equality: Promoting the Role and Image of Women in the Southern Mediterranean Audiovisual Sector” is organizing two meetings to advocate for more gender equality in the audio-visual sector in the targeted region. The first meeting will be held on 25 February 2019 in Tunis and will be hosted by the Higher School of Audiovisual and Cinema (ESAC). The second one, in March 2019 in Amman, will be organised by the Screen Institute Beirut (SIB). During the events, the local partners ESAC from Tunisia and SIB from Lebanon will present the activities, events and publications of SouthMed WiA. The beneficiaries of the sub-granted projects will give an overview on their actions and will share their experiences, achievements and challenges encountered during their projects implementation.

These meetings aim to bring together different key stakeholders, authorities and professionals from different Southern Mediterranean countries in order to create a space for dialogue and propose possible strategies, actions and measures on how to improve the participation of women in the audio-visual sector and the use of their image in the local audio-visual products.
